Course:

The course will consist of open flowing tracks, tight creek sections and across scrub, rock and open terrain. Riders are to follow the marked course which is identified by arrows and bunting.

All riders are welcome to walk the course, which will be open from 3pm to 5pm Saturday the 15th June. Strictly walking only, no competitor may ride the course before the event starts.

Compulsory Riders Briefing:

All riders will be required to sign to say they have attended rider briefing and or random numbers will be called to ascertain riders are present.

Noise:

Random Static noise testing will take place on Sunday during Machine Examination, please ensure you check the Supplementary Regulations and GCR for the acceptable noise emissions. No person may compete in any event on a machine whose emissions exceed the limits as noted in GCR 12.10.1.1. If a machine fails it can be presented for re-testing several times.
