**1. ANNOUNCEMENT:**

The Gawler Motorcycle Club, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct a Closed to Club X Country for Solo Motorcycles on the 19<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at Worlds End Hwy, Robertstown.

**2. JURISDICTION:**

2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number C221095 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Junior National, Senior National or a one event licence.

2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.

**BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.**

**3. ENTRIES:**

3.1. Entries open forthwith and close the **Wednesday prior for Online Entries via RIDERNET.**

3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by Gawler Motorcycle Club, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.

3.3. Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee or via RIDERNET will be accepted.

3.4. **NOTE:- LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE GAWLER MOTORCYCLE CLUB.**

**4. INSURANCE:**

4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

**5. MEDICAL SERVICES:**

First Care Medical will be in attendance.

**6. ENTRY FEE:**

6.1. Senior \$85 / Junior \$60, Per Rider. One Event Licences \$75 plus entry fee

**7. CLASSES OF COMPETITION:**

**Seniors:** Pony Express – (two rider team, Maximum one Expert per team))  
Ironman

**Juniors A:** (riders both between 8 -11 as of the 1<sup>st</sup> January) – (65cc 2 stroke) & (85cc 2stroke/150cc 4 stroke)  
Pony Express or Ironman.

**Juniors B** (riders both between 12 -16 as of the 1<sup>st</sup> January) – (100cc - 125cc 2 Stroke) & (128-150cc 2stroke/200 - 250cc 4 Stroke)  
Pony Express or Ironman.

**8. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:**

Awards will be given out to the top 3 positions in each class. Presentations will be held after the event.

## **9 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:**

- 9.1 To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be a minimum of 3.
- 9.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and / or prize money, will be at the discretion of the Gawler Motorcycle Club, subject to Motorcycling SA Inc. approval.

## **10 RACE FORMAT:**

Teams will consist of rider pairings (Pony Express) Teams shall complete the marked course by riding for a given time, completing laps alternatively (eg: one lap per rider, per pairing) until the time nominated by the Gawler Motorcycle Club is complete. Rider pairings can consist of 2 senior riders. If a rider at some point in his career of motorcycling has been deemed Expert (in any discipline), they may not ride with another Expert.

Ironman riders will complete the marked course, completing laps for the duration of the time given for that race.  
A sighting lap will be given to all riders.

## **11 MACHINES AND RIDERS:**

- 11.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Enduro competition.

## **12 RIDERS' BRIEFING:**

**A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend.. Details will be included in the final instructions.**

## **13. Anti - Doping Policy**

- 13.1. All competitors, crew, parents / guardians and officials are advised that drug testing may take place in accordance with MA's Anti-Doping Policy, under the authority of Sport Integrity Australia.
- 13.2. Athletes are advised to download the Sports Integrity Australia app. If athletes have any doubts over Sports Integrity Australia requirements, they should visit the website [www.sportintegrity.gov.au](http://www.sportintegrity.gov.au). It is recommended athletes contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline (1300 027 232) for further information. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed, at the discretion of MSA, until the results of the tests are known.
- 13.3. The Anti-Doping policy is available on the MA website the under General Information page.
- 13.4. For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 6.30am on race day with completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

## **14.0 Numbers**

Riders may choose their own numbers. Any double ups will be notified and preference given to first entry or if their number is state assigned.

## **15 CODE OF CONDUCT:**

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

## **16 TIMETABLE:**

- 8:00-9:00am - Junior machine examination and rider sign on
- 9:00-9:30am - Junior's rider's briefing and sight lap (Junior A, followed by Junior B)
- 9:30-10:30am - Junior's A Race
- 10:30-12:00- Junior B Race
- 8:30-12:00 - Senior's machine examination and rider sign on
- 12:00-12:30 - Senior's rider's briefing and sight lap
- 12:30-3:30pm - Senior's Race

The above times are a guideline only and are subject to change at any time.

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 8:00am with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

## **17 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:**

A marked course of approx 8-10 km's in length, consisting of natural terrain including rocks, creek, dirt & scrub.  
The course will be marked with, arrows and bunting. Anyone found to be not sticking to the marked course, maybe asked to leave and take no part in future Gawler Motorcycle Club events.

## **18 STARTS:**

Riders will leave in their respective classes as determined by the Gawler Motorcycle Club on the day of the event.

## **19 RACING:**

Junior A will be racing for 1hr plus 1 lap.  
Junior B will be racing for 1.5hrs plus 1 lap.  
Seniors will be racing for 2.5hrs plus one lap.  
Race times are a guide only and are subject to change at any time

**20. NOISE:**

Noise emissions as per the 2022 MoMS

**21. GST:**

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prizemoney. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prizemoney over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

**22. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:**

- No tear offs are allowed in Enduro events.
- All refuelling must be done with the motorcycle engine off. Riders must not be seated on the Motorcycle whilst refuelling.
- Environmental mats must be placed under all motorcycles whilst refuelling or changing oils. Carpet or any material not made for absorption of petroleum products is not allowed to be used. Enviro Mats will be available to purchase at Sign On for \$10
- It is strongly recommended all riders have a suitable fire extinguisher in their pit area.
  
- Presentations will be held at the conclusion of the days racing
- Basic Catering will be available.
- Toilet Facilities will be at the venue
- Camping will be available unless noted in the Final riders instructions.
